# Strategy on protection, return and recovery for the North-East Nigeria

Promoting integrated development and humanitarian solutions in principled manner

February 2017



# Objective

- To operationalize the protection, return and recovery strategy
- The voluntary return to places of origin; local integration in areas of displacement; or resettlement in areas of displacement of IDPs and refugees towards a resilient recovery of communities and livelihoods;

# Expected outcome

- Develop an action plan for implementation which support detailed sector plans and contribution for implementation.
- Based on the protection, return and recovery strategy and Buhari plan, the action plan will be developed in consultative process. The process will be supported by UNDP and UNHCR.

# Sector planned

- **Strengthening security** (police, JTF, army – HR, DDR, Mine action, CIMIC, logistics)
- **Promote protection** (Legal systems, peace and conflict transformation, De-radicalization, protection of vulnerable groups, and people with special needs, psychosocial support, SGBV protection and support)
- **Basic services** (Public Works, Water, Energy, NEMA/ SEMA, Education, Health – shelter reconstruction, WASH, debris management, health and education infrastructure, rural roads and bridges, solid waste management);
- **Economic recovery and livelihoods** (RRR, NEMA/ SEMA, LGA, Private Sector, Agriculture – SME, Micro credit/ finance, agro-input and business, market reconstruction, cash for work, skills development)
- **Peace, reconciliation and social cohesion** (conflict analysis, leadership dialogue, improve legal, transitional justice, RoL, PR)

# Sequenced

- First step: LGA and locality handed over by military and security forces to civil authorities – mines/ UXO cleared, security in place
- Second step: LGA/ local plans are made; temporary basic services are installed, return package delivered, cash for work programmes available, returnees registered, safe corridors in place, transport is available, temporary shelters in place;
- Third step: permanent housing is reconstructed, public and private infrastructure is reconstructed, permanent basic services are reconstructed;

Also:

- strengthening all MDA's following sector plans to deliver sequenced area specific technical support: refer Buhari plan.
- Strengthen MRRR/ PCNI in data collection, analysis, dissemination.
